for women who have experienced violence

Welcome to the London Women's Directory.

The most important thing to know is that if you have experienced violence, of any kind, it is not your fault, and nothing you did made it happen.

The second most important thing to know is that there are services out there which can help you. They can help you get away from violent partners; learn self defence or new skills to make you feel safer or help you get your life back; listen while you talk through your experiences; or give you information about other services which can address specific issues you find hard to deal with.

The services listed in this book represent all kinds of help, for all kinds of experiences you may have had. Through them, you can access counselling, accommodation, legal advice, help with benefits, practical health advice, workshops where you can learn life skills, and training or education opportunities. And they can help you around domestic violence, prostitution, hate crime, stalking, rape, forced marriage, female genital mutilation, gang violence and much more.

Services should not judge you, or try to tell you what to do. They will simply listen to what you have to say, give you advice around your situation and tell you how they can help if you want them to. They will treat everything you say in confidence.

Services are listed alphabetically, and the index at the start of the directory lists services by area and issue (eg domestic violence, rape, alcohol, forced marriage). This means if you have experienced domestic violence, for example, you can look under that heading in the index; or if you just want to look for a service in your area, you can look under the headings National, Londonwide, North London, South London, East London, West London or Central London.

We have created symbols for each issue and each way a service can help you, so you can see at a glance if a service is for you. ‘Signposting’ means that a service can give you information about other services which may be able to help. A list of all abbreviations used in this directory e.g. DV, CSA etc. is listed on page 5.

We have also provided a brief overview of what you can expect from each service type.

And lastly, please remember – you are not alone. Whatever you have been through, people can help, and life can get better.

Advocacy is when someone supports you to deal with a problem or issue. Advocacy can help you to speak up, or can speak on your behalf to help you get the services you need.

Signposting is when someone helps you to find other services and/or organisations that can support you.

A refuge is temporary accommodation that is given to women who are escaping violence.

Outreach is when a service comes to you, instead of you going to them.

Prostitution services are for women involved in prostitution who need support around health, safety, advice, and/or help in leaving the industry.

Sanctuary Schemes are services run by local councils to help women who feel vulnerable or threatened by partners or ex-partners to stay in their homes. For example, they can make homes more secure with new locks, stronger doors and window grilles.
