 - Eaves' drop in centre supports women who have been victims of violence, including rape or domestic violence, and provides support, advice, counselling, workshops to help women with independent living and tips on how to prepare if they need to leave and stay away from the family home. This centre is available to all London women, including your staff, colleagues or clients.
 - We can also help change attitudes and raise awareness at your workplace, which, in turn, can help save lives.
- **Employee volunteering**
 - There are a number of opportunities for staff to volunteer with Eaves. We are always looking for dedicated volunteers to support our work.
